Release Notes

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Wireless Internet and Data Communication

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Installation

- **This version of BTW-CE 1.4.1 will only install on PocketPC running the Microsoft® Windows Mobile™ 2003.**
- **Your PocketPC must be connected to your desktop (via ActiveSync) during the installation. This is required for the installation process to properly update the PocketPC.**
- If BTW-CE 1.0.0.11 CEDemoExplorer (or any release of BTW-CE prior to BTW-CE 1.2.0) is installed on your Pocket PC, it must be uninstalled before installing BTW-CE 1.2.1. Please uninstall BTW-CE 1.0.0.11 from both your PC and PDA using the Add/Remove Programs screen of ActiveSync.
- Should you re-install BTW-CE 1.4.1, you must execute the full installation procedure (i.e. run Setup.exe), instead of re-installing BTW-CE from ActiveSync (via the Add/Remove Programs option).
- In some rare instances, the installation of BTW-CE may appear to freeze on the PocketPC. When this happens, the progress bar shown during the file transfer is and remains empty. This is an ActiveSync problem, which can be resolved by removing the Pocket PC from its cradle; this triggers the installation and allows it to finish.
- The current BTW-CE release does not directly support installation over the Compaq Bluetooth Wireless Pack. Please contact WIDCOMM's Technical Support for manual installation instructions.

Bluetooth Manager

- If pairing is required when establishing a network (LAP) or a modem (DUN) connection, then a connection must be created via the Bluetooth Manager.
- When you disconnect a network (LAP) or modem (DUN) connection through the Bluetooth Manager, a notification message may appear. That message can be ignored.
- It is not possible to cancel the process of establishing a connection to a remote device once started. Should an error happen, the process will terminate itself after a few seconds.

Bluetooth File Explorer

- During a PUT operation to a BTW device (server), the PocketPC must be soft reset if the Bluetooth CF card is removed during the file transfer. Note that this problem only happens with BTW devices (servers).

Personal Network

- When hosting a personal network, security settings are not enforced for devices that are added via the **Join a personal network** wizard (**Host a personal network** option). However, all the security settings are applied when client devices initiate the connection to the personal network.

Others

- Bluetooth applications may close when the device is powered off and back on.
- DUN Bluetooth connections don't terminate when the ISP connection drops.
- If two or more devices within proximity have the same name, the Bluetooth Browser will display an entry for each, but it is not possible to identify which one is which.
